Roadford Cafe and Walks 11 min drive.

The Roadford Lake Activity Centre offers equipment hire and lessons for sailing, kayaking, canoeing, and paddleboarding. Take a 50 min walk, or cycle around the reservoir and refreshments in the Cafe.

Granite Way, Lydford 30 min drive
